The incumbent carries out the duties of Registrar as set out in the *Professional Governance Act* and Engineers and Geoscientists BC's bylaws and oversees the development, implementation and execution of policies and procedures necessary to carry out the Registrar's statutory duties.

This position requires the incumbent to have a broad fundamental understanding of the professions of engineering and geoscience and of the educational and practice requirements for both. The ideal candidate is a confident leader with a career background in regulation and/or policy development who is known for their strategic impact, progressive management, and innovative process improvement skillset. Of utmost importance is a background developing and maintaining excellence of process, service and business decisions.
